## FOODSHARE (FOOD STAMP) PROGRAM 242-7441

**Monday-Friday: 7:45 am-4:30 pm**

## FoodShare Helpline 1-877-366-3635

Additional help to apply for Foodshare offered by **Second Harvest** Volunteers who will help you learn whether you may be eligible for FoodShare benefits and tell you where you can get free personalized application assistance. Their number is toll-free.

## MEALS ON WHEELS 276-7598

Noon or evening meal delivered by volunteers to anyone who is homebound. No age requirement. Meal delivered every day of the week and every week of the year. Minimal cost. Financial assistance available.
