

## Free Immunizations for Children through 18 Years

Available to children who:

- Are completely uninsured
- Have Medical Assistance or Badger Care
- Have 'major medical insurance' (only covering hospitalization; no preventive care coverage)
- Are Native American or Alaska Native

## Childhood Immunization Schedule

Age	Vaccine
Birth	Hepatitis B
2 months	DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis), Hib (Haemophilus influenza), Polio, Rotavirus, Pneumococcal, Hepatitis B
4 months	DTaP, Hib, Polio, Rotavirus Pneumococcal
6 months	DTaP, Hib, Polio, Rotavirus Pneumococcal, Hepatitis B
12-18 months	DTaP, Hib, Pneumococcal, MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), Varicella (chicken pox), Hepatitis A (2 <sup>nd</sup> dose 6 months later)
4-6 years	DTaP, Polio, MMR, Varicella
11-12 years	Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis), Meningococcal, HPV (Human Papillomavirus Vaccine—series of 3)
16 years	Meningococcal booster
6 months-18 years	Influenza (yearly)

## Adult Immunization Schedule

### Adults 19 years and older who:

- Are completely uninsured,
- Do NOT have Medical Assistance or Badger Care, or
- Have major medical insurance (only covering hospitalization; no preventive care coverage)

### Vaccines available:

- **Tdap:** especially important if in contact with infants
- **Influenza:** seasonal, Sept-June
- **HPV:** 19-26 years of age

Other vaccines to those who qualify by age, risk factors or through the Merck Vaccine Assistance Program

- Hepatitis A & B
- Meningitis
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- Pneumococcal
- Varicella (Chickenpox)
- Zoster (Shingles)
