

ORDER OF PUBLIC HEALTH MADISON & DANE COUNTY

SAFER AT HOME ORDER DATE OF ORDER: MARCH 25, 2020

Please read this Order carefully. Violation of or failure to comply with this Order is a crime punishable by fine, imprisonment, or both. (Wis. Stats. §§ 252.03 & 252.25) and a violation of Dane County Ordinance §46.25(1) and Madison General Ordinance §7.05(6) punishable by forfeiture.

On March 24, 2020, at the direction of Governor Tony Evers, the Secretary –designee of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services issued Emergency Order #12, SAFER AT HOME ORDER, a copy of which is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein. That Order is effective at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, March 25, 2020 and will remain in effect until 8:00 a.m. on Friday, April 24, 2020, or until a superseding order is issued.

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF WISCONSIN STATUTE SECTION 252.03, THE PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER OF THE CITY OF MADISON AND DANE COUNTY ORDERS that for enforcement purposes all of the provisions of Wisconsin Department of Health Services Emergency Order #12 dated March 24, 2020 are hereby adopted as an Order of Public Health Madison Dane County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any subsequent Emergency Orders issued by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services regarding COVID-19 are hereby adopted as an Order of Public Health Madison and Dane County unless this provision is subsequently rescinded, amended or superseded.

This Order supersedes the Public Health Officer Order issued on March 15, 2020, related to COVID-19. All orders of the Governor of Wisconsin and Department of Health Services remain in effect.
