


Key Takeaways

- More than 9 in 10 Dane County students (92.1%) met all minimum immunization requirements in 2022-2023, slightly better than all students statewide.
- However, more Dane County students were behind schedule or waived one or more immunizations in 2022-2023 compared to the prior school year.
- The most common reason by far for waiving any immunization was personal conviction (more than 9 in 10 waivers), followed by medical (2 in 10) and religious reasons (1 in 10).


More than 9 in 10 Dane County students met all minimum immunization requirements, slightly better than all students statewide.



Fewer Dane County students are behind schedule or waive at least one immunization (or all immunizations) compared to all students statewide.



The proportions of Dane County students who waived at least one immunization, waived all immunizations, or were behind schedule increased between the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 school years.
