



APPENDIX: DCYA DATA TABLES

Percents

The following tables contain all of the Dane County Youth Assessment (DCYA) data for high school students, broken out by Asian (Hmong), Asian (not Hmong), and all students. The heading at the top of each page indicates which topic(s) the questions on that page cover (e.g., the first page covers “Demographics”). Each question is displayed as a blue row in the table. Below each question are the response options to the question and the percent of each group that selected each response option. For example, for the first question listed (Do other people see you as BIPOC (Black, indigenous, person of color)?), 44.1% of Hmong youth responded “Yes,” 15.9% responded “No,” and 40.0% responded “Not Sure.” These percentages are estimates, as the survey was not administered to 100% of youth in the participating school districts. However, the percentages are intended to be generalized to all students in these school districts.

Confidence Intervals and Coefficient of Variation

Along with percents, the tables also include the lower and upper confidence intervals (CIs) and the coefficient of variation (CV). These help us to determine how reliable the data are and how the estimates might differ from the “true” value. This report uses 95% CIs. This means that if we did the survey over and over with different youth, 95% of the time the result would be in between the lower and upper CIs. The more survey responses we have, the smaller and more precise the CI will be. If we have a smaller number of responses (which is often the case when breaking out the data for Hmong youth, as they are a small group compared to other racial groups), the interval will be wider, meaning we're less certain about the true value. Using the first question listed as our example again, the estimate for the “Yes” response for Hmong youth is 44.1%, but the “true” value is likely anywhere from 35.6% - 52.6%.

The coefficient of variation (CV) tells us about the reliability of a survey estimate. Like the confidence interval, the CV is greatly influenced by the number of survey responses we have. The closer the CV is to zero, the more precise the estimate is. In our example, the CV for the “Yes” response for Hmong youth is 0.10, or 10%.

Finally, for the purposes of this report, estimates were considered reliable if the confidence interval did not touch 0 or 100 and the CV was less than or equal to 0.3. This means the number of responses to a particular question was large enough for us to be confident in our estimate. Estimates that do not meet this standard in the data tables are noted with an asterisk, along with this note: “Percent based on a small sample size and may be unreliable. Interpret with caution.”

Statistical Significance

We can use the above statistical measures to help us determine whether the difference between two estimates is a true difference in the population, or whether the difference was likely to be due to random chance. When CIs for two estimates do not overlap, we can say that the two estimates likely represent a true difference because they are statistically significantly different from each other. In our example, the CI for the “Yes” response for Hmong youth is 35.6% - 52.6%, while the CI for the “Yes” response for all youth is 15.3% - 17.8%. These do not overlap, indicating that Hmong youth were significantly more likely than all youth to respond “Yes” to the question of “Do other people see you as BIPOC?” Alternatively, when CIs do overlap, it means that additional statistical testing is necessary to determine if the observed difference is likely a true difference.
