Who We Can Vaccinate

- People six months and older who:
 - Have no insurance for immunizations
 - Have Medical Assistance or BadgerCare
 - Are under 19 and Native American or Alaska Native
 - Have most other types of insurance
 - If you have insurance, please try to bring your insurance information

Accessing Your Immunization Records

- If you were vaccinated in Wisconsin, you can access your vaccination record using the Wisconsin Immunization Registry (WIR).
- To access your record, you'll need to provide your name and date of birth. You'll also need to provide your social security number OR Medicaid ID OR Health Care Member ID.
