# The Details

## Who We Can Vaccinate

- **Children 18 and under who:**
  - Have no insurance for immunizations
  - Have Medical Assistance or BadgerCare
  - Are Native American or Alaska Native
- **Adults 19 and older who do not have insurance, only Covid and Flu.**

## Accessing Your Immunization Records

- If you were vaccinated in Wisconsin, you can access your vaccination record using the Wisconsin Immunization Registry (WIR).
- To access your record, you'll need to provide your name and date of birth. You'll also need to provide your social security number **OR** Medicaid ID **OR** Health Care Member ID.

## Vaccines We Offer

Different vaccines are offered by age. Talk to our staff for details.

| Vaccine                                             | Kids (0-18) | Adults (19+) |
|-----------------------------------------------------|-------------|--------------|
| COVID-19                                            | ✓           | ✓            |
| DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus, and acellular pertussis) | ✓           | ✗            |
| Flu (influenza; Oct-Jun)                            | ✓           | ✓            |
| Hepatitis A or B                                    | ✓           | ✗            |
| Hib ( <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b)         | ✓           | ✗            |
| HPV (human papillomavirus)                          | ✓           | ✗            |
| Meningococcal ACWY (or B upon request)              | ✓           | ✗            |
| MMR (measles, mumps, and rubella)                   | ✓           | ✗            |
| Pneumococcal                                        | ✓           | ✗            |
| Polio                                               | ✓           | ✗            |
| Rotavirus                                           | ✓           | ✗            |
| RSV (for infants and high-risk toddlers; Oct-Mar)   | ✓           | ✗            |
| Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis)     | ✓           | ✗            |
| Varicella (chicken pox)                             | ✓           | ✗            |
