

NON-STORM WATER DISCHARGE PERMIT APPLICATION

The City of Madison regulates the discharge of non-storm water (wastewater) into the Madison storm sewer system, lakes, streams or ground surface under [Ordinance 7.47](#). The Health Department is responsible for monitoring the wastewater quality.

This permit, issued by the City of Madison, **is in addition** to any State wastewater discharge approval requirements. The applicant is granted a discharge permit after:

- 1) Submitting a completed application to Public Health Madison & Dane County
- 2) Paying all fees (see fee explanation below)
- 3) Approval of the application by Public Health Madison & Dane County and the City of Madison Engineering Division

Complete this application based upon best available information. It describes the location, source, and characteristics of the wastewater discharge. This application must be completed by new (first time permit) dischargers and permit holders making changes from the previous application.

Explanation of Fees

- **Initial Application Fee (\$75)** is nonrefundable and paid once for each permit and covers application handling and inspections.
- **Annual Discharge Permit Fee** is an annual fee that is based upon the annual volume of wastewater discharge. It covers the cost of monitoring the wastewater quality and is payable after the application is approved. The permit year is July 1 through June 30.
